

**A CHECKLIST OF EARLY AUSTRALIAN BOOKSELLERS' AND
AUCTIONEERS' CATALOGUES AND ADVERTISEMENTS : 1800 — 1849
PART II : 1840 — 1844***

IN THE FOLLOWING LISTS the first two columns record the title and date of the newspaper in which an advertisement appeared or the source of catalogues, with Ferguson numbers where appropriate. Catalogues not described by Ferguson have been described at the end of the lists.

The third column records the name of the auctioneer or bookseller, the date of auction sales and any available information about the provenance of the books. An index to names of book owners and suppliers mentioned here will be included with Part III of this "Checklist".

The fourth column records the number of volumes listed for sale. A dash means that no numbers were given, or no titles listed. Except where the source is a catalogue or an advertisement which mentions a specific number of volumes, the figures in this column are not necessarily an accurate reflection of the number of volumes for sale.

Lists have been arranged chronologically within present state boundaries. The omission of any particular year means that no advertisements or catalogues for that year and location have been sighted.
